Secure Android Installation Guide (Outside Google Play Store)

✨ Why This Guide Exists (Please Read First)

MsgPilot Enterprise is a **business and enterprise version** of MsgPilot.

For flexibility, privacy, and enterprise licensing, it is distributed **directly from our official website**, not from Google Play Store.

Because of this, Android will ask you to **confirm a few security permissions** before installation.

👉 This guide exists to:

- Explain **why** Android shows these messages
- Show you **exactly what to tap**
- Keep your phone **safe before, during, and after installation**
- Help users on **different phone brands**

✅ These steps are **normal worldwide** for enterprise apps used by companies, banks, and professional tools.

🔒 Important Safety Note

You are installing MsgPilot Enterprise **only from our official website**.

Never install the app from unknown links, WhatsApp messages, or third-party sites.

● PART 1 — Downloading MsgPilot Enterprise

Step 1- Download the App

1. Open your browser (Chrome / Samsung Internet).
2. Visit: msgpilot.khtechgroup.com
3. Tap **Download MsgPilot Enterprise**.
4. Wait until the download finishes.

📌 You may see a message like:

“This type of file may harm your device”

✅ This is a **standard Android warning** for apps outside Play Store — it does **not** mean the app is unsafe.

Tap **Download anyway**.



● PART 2 — Google Play Protect (Very Important)

Google Play Protect sometimes blocks enterprise apps **by default**, even if they are safe.

You need to **temporarily turn it off**, install the app, then **turn it back on**.

Step 2 - Disable Play Protect (Temporary)

How to remove Google Play Protect in the Play Store?

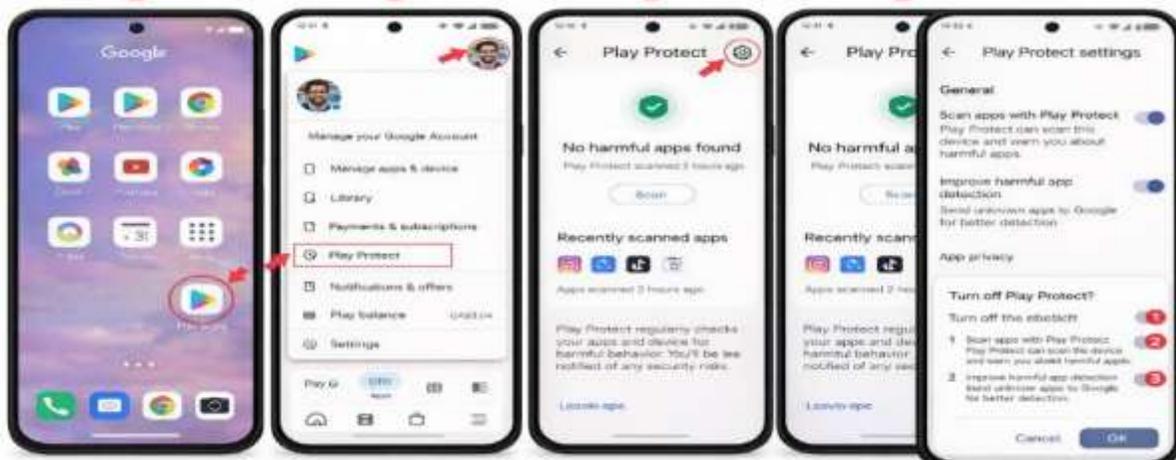
You can turn off Google Play Protect directly from the Google Play Store app on your Android device. Follow these steps:

1. Open the Google Play Store app.
2. Tap your profile icon at the top right.
3. Tap “Play Protect.”
4. Open “Settings.”
5. Turn off “Scan apps with Play Protect.”

How to Disable Google play Protect on Android 14

Google Play Protect helps protect your device, but in some cases it may block apps that you trust. If you need to disable Google Play Protect for sideloading or to monitor how an app is working, follow the steps below:

1. Open the Play Store app.
2. Tap your profile icon at the top right of the screen.
3. Select “Play Protect” from the menu.
4. Tap the Settings icon.
5. Turn off both available options:
 - a. Tap on “High priority.”
 - b. Select “Turn OFF.”





How to disable Google Play Protect on Android 13?

1. Open **Settings** on your device.
2. Go to the **Security** section.
3. Tap on **Google Play Protect**.
4. Tap the Settings icon in the top-right corner.
5. Turn off **Scan apps with Play Protect**.



How to turn off Google Play Protect on Android 12?

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Tap **Security**.
3. Select **Google Play Protect**.
4. Tap the Settings icon in the top-right corner.
5. Turn off **Scan apps with Play Protect**.

How to turn off Google Play Protect notification on Android 11 and Android 10?

1. Open **Settings**, then go to the **Security** section.
2. Tap on **Google Play Protect**.
3. Tap the Settings icon in the top-right corner.
4. Turn off **Scan apps with Play Protect** to disable it.

How to turn off Google Play Protect notification on Android 8?

1. Open **Settings** on your device.
2. Tap on **Apps**.
3. Select **Google Play Store** from the list.
4. Tap on **Notifications**.



How to turn off Google Play Protect notification on Android 7?

1. Open **Settings** on your Android device.
2. Tap on **Notifications**.
3. Select **Google Play Store**.
4. Turn on **Block all**.

✦ This is temporary and safe when installing from a trusted source.

● PART 3 — Allow Installation from This Source

Step 3 - Allow the Browser to Install Apps

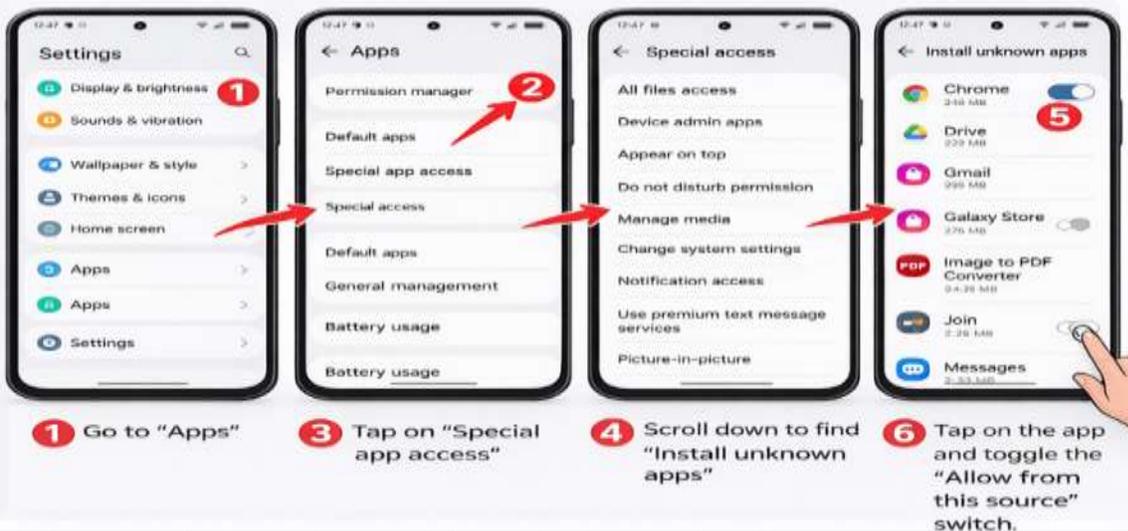
Android devices include a built-in security feature that prevents installing apps from outside the Play Store. However, since many useful apps are not available on the Play Store, you may need to disable this restriction. Follow the next steps to learn how to allow installation from unknown sources on your Android device.

- ✓ This permission applies **only to your browser** and can be disabled later.
- ✓ if you start the installation and you got the message

“Your phone is not allowed to install apps from this source”

How to install Unknown Sources applications in Android 13?

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Go to **Apps**.
3. Tap on **Special app access**.
4. Scroll down and select **Install unknown apps**.
5. You will see a list of apps that are allowed to install content on your device.
6. Tap the app you want and turn on **Allow from this source**.





How to Install apks from unknown sources in Android 10, 11 and 12?

1. Open **Settings** on your device.
2. Go to **Apps**.
3. Tap **Special app access**. If you don't see it, first tap **Advanced**, then select **Special app access**.
4. Tap **Install unknown apps**.
5. Choose the app you will use to install other apps (usually a browser or the Files app).
6. Turn on **Allow from this source**.

How to install applications from unknown sources in Android 9 and 8?

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Go to **Apps & notifications**.
3. Tap **Advanced**.
4. Select **Special app access**.
5. Tap **Install unknown apps**.
6. Choose the app you want to use to install apps from unknown sources.
7. Turn on **Allow from this source**.

How to install Unknown Sources applications in Android 7 and below?

1. Open the app menu on your device and tap **Settings**.
2. Scroll down and select **Security & fingerprint** or **Security**.
3. Scroll down and tap **Unknown sources**.
4. When the warning message appears, tap **OK**.
5. Exit Settings and install the APK.

How to Install Apps from Unknown Sources on Samsung?

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Tap **Apps**.
3. Tap the three-dots icon in the top-right corner.
4. Select **Special access**.
5. Tap **Install unknown apps**.
6. Turn on the toggle next to the app you want to use to install third-party apps.

If this does not work on your Samsung device, use the alternative steps below:

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Tap **Biometrics and security** or **Privacy**.



3. Tap **Install unknown apps**.
4. Turn on the toggle for the app you will use to install apps.

How to Install Apps from Unknown Sources on Xiaomi?

1. Open the **Settings** app.
2. Scroll down and tap **Additional settings**.
3. Tap **Privacy**.
4. Find **Unknown sources** and turn it on to enable the option.

● PART 4 — Installation Complete

Step 4 – Open MsgPilot Enterprise

1. Wait for installation to finish
2. Tap **Open**
3. MsgPilot Enterprise is now ready

📱 PART 5 — Phone Brand–Specific Notes

🌀 Samsung (One UI)

Settings → Security & Privacy → Install unknown apps
→ Browser → Allow from this source

🌀 Xiaomi / Redmi / POCO (MIUI / HyperOS)

Settings → Privacy Protection → Special permissions
→ Install unknown apps → Browser → Allow

⚠️ Xiaomi may show extra warnings — this is normal.

🌀 OPPO / Realme (ColorOS)

Settings → Security → Install unknown apps
→ Browser → Allow

🌀 Huawei

Settings → Security → Install unknown apps
→ Browser → Allow

🌀 Vivo

Settings → Security & Privacy → Install unknown apps
→ Browser → Allow



🔒 PART 6 — VERY IMPORTANT: Return Your Phone to Safe Mode
After installation, we **strongly recommend** restoring all protections.

Step 5 – Re-Enable Google Play Protect

1. Open **Google Play Store**
2. Tap profile photo → **Play Protect**
3. Tap **⚙️ Settings**
4. Turn **ON**:
 - Scan apps with Play Protect
 - Improve harmful app detection

Step 6 – Disable “Install from This Source”

1. Open **Settings**
2. Go to **Install unknown apps**
3. Select your browser
4. Turn **OFF** “Allow from this source”

✅ Your phone is now fully protected again.

🧠 Common Questions

Is this dangerous?

❌ No. These steps are standard for enterprise apps.

Will this affect my data?

❌ No. MsgPilot does not access data without permission.

Do I need to repeat this later?

❌ No. Only for first installation.

Can I uninstall anytime?

✅ Yes, like any normal app.
